



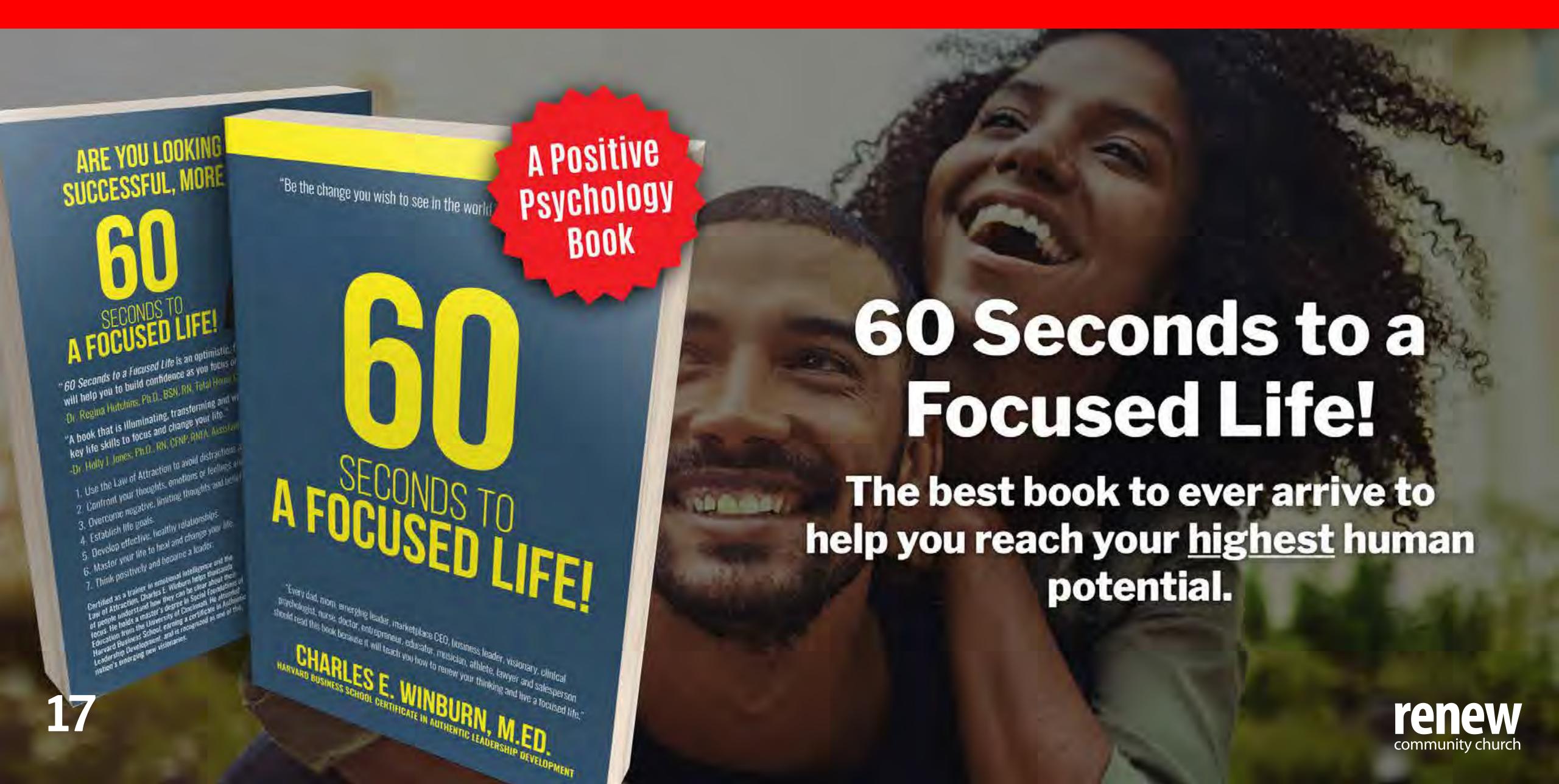

#### How your God-created self was stolen

Al Research



- 1. Negative beliefs transferred to us by our parents, guardians, teachers, and peers
- 2. Limiting beliefs, passed down from generation to generation
- 3. Negative vibrations or emotions given to us through transgenerational epigenetic inheritance



- 4. Holding onto negative memories
- 5. Unresolved childhood trauma that shows up in adulthood
- 6. The failure of parents to teach their children that they are the righteousness of God



7. The church's overemphasis on going to heaven, instead of teaching that the Earth is the Lord's and the fullness thereof; however, we are already in heavenly places in Christ Jesus



- 8. Parents, guardians, trustees, and churches failing to teach children about their Godcreated self, which involves the following:
  - We are created after the image of God and we look like God and not Adam (we came out of God, not Adam.
  - We are kings and priests



- We are gods
- We are the righteousness of God
- Greater is He that is in us than He that is in the world; we are sons of God
- God is in us. "We are the expression of God in me."



9. So-called Christian parents and Christian churches have helped to add to the trauma of both adults and children over the centuries by overemphasizing teaching negative Church doctrine in the following areas:



- Teaching a sin-consciousness instead of a God-consciousness.
- Teaching a hell-consciousness doctrine by scaring the hell out of people; however, instead of teaching that God is a God of love.



 Teaching a punishmentconsciousness that says you're going to hell when Jesus Christ has already nailed hell to the cross. Scaring people that they are going to die before their time if they don't repent of their sins. This is an over-emphasis on a sin conscious that the church has perpetuated on everyone which helps to further people's trauma.



· Teaching children how to be religious instead of being spiritual and/or being a spirit being. Our children are talked to be spirited, but not spiritual (jumping and shouting is being spirited, but not being spiritual).



 Overemphasis on the church being the most important entity in the universe, instead of teaching that the kingdom of God is the most important. That's because Jesus is king over His domain, even the universe. We are not to preach the gospel of the church; we are to preach the gospel of the kingdom. That's biblical.



#### Why have billions of people lost their God-created self?

#### 1. What is your God-created self?

- a. It is your divine right to walk in the image of God and not in the image of your parents, guardians, trustees, teachers, bishops, pastors, peers, churches, or anyone else.
- b. It is your divine right to embrace your true self and identity, which includes:



- · You are a little god.
- You are the righteousness of God.
- You are kings and priests.
- You are more than a conqueror.
- Greater is He that is in you than he that is in the world.
- Guarding you, the hope of the world.



2. What does it mean to possess your God-created self? It means you reflect the character and moral qualities of God on the Earth as it relates to the following:



- a. You are to reflect God's image in the Earth.
- b. You ought to reflect God's righteousness in the Earth.
- c. You ought to reflect God's love, mercy, and justice in the Earth.



- 3. What does it mean to have a God-created self?
  - a. It means to walk in both your divinity and humanity on the Earth and be guided by the power of the Holy Spirit in the name of Jesus Christ, the Anointed One, in His anointing.



- b. Romans 8:14: For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.
- c. The Spirit itself bears witness with our spirit that we are the children of God.



- 4. What does it mean to have a God-created self?
  - a. It means to recognize that you are uniquely created in the image of God, which gives you intrinsic worth, dignity, and purpose. In other words, your purpose is found in your Godcreated self.



b. Your God-created self is given to you as a gift of God, not based on performance, status, or appearance, but on God's mercy, grace, and love for you.



- 5. What does it mean to have a God-created self?
  - a. It's a call to servanthood and stewardship—using your gifts and resources to be a blessing to others on Earth and in the age to come. This is your purpose.



- 6. What does it mean to have a God-created self?
  - a. It involves transformation, confession, repentance, and prayer.



- 7. What does it mean to have a God-created self?
  - a. It means that you have the power to call on the Father in the Name of Jesus for what you want.

- 8. What does it mean to have a God-created self?
  - a. It means you are a finished work of God.

Colossians 2:9-10; John 19:30

### 1. We are kings and priests

- Revelation 1:6: And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.
- Revelation 5:10: And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.



- 2. We have been made after the righteous of God
  - 2 Corinthians 5:21: For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

### 3. We are the righteous of God

- 2 Corinthians 5:21 emphasizes righteousness in Christ.
- Romans 5:17: For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.



 Romans 3:24: Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus.



### 4. We are in heavenly places

- Ephesians 2:6: And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus.
- Ephesians 1:3: Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ.



### 5. We are more than conquerors

- Romans 8:37: Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.
- 1 John 4:4: Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.



# 6. We were created before the foundation of the world

 Ephesians 1:4: According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love.



• Hebrews 4:3: For we which have believed do enter into rest, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.



- 7. The kingdoms of this world are the kingdoms of our Lord
  - Revelation 11:15: And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.



• Daniel 2:44: And in the days of these kings shall the God of heaven set up a kingdom which shall never be destroyed: and the kingdom shall not be left to other people, but it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand for ever.



# 8. Greater is he that is in us than he that is in the world

- 1 John 4:4: Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.
- Romans 8:31: If God be for us, who can be against us?



### 9. We are "gods"

- Psalm 82:6: I have said, Ye are gods; and all of you are children of the most High.
- John 10:34-36: Jesus quotes Psalm 82:6 and affirms, calling it scripture: Is it not written in your law, I said, Ye are gods?...



#### 10. We are the sons of God

 John 1:12: But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name.



 Romans 8:14-16: For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. and The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God.



• 1 John 3:1: Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not.



# How do you reclaim your God-created self back from the people who stole it from you?

## 1. Reclaim your boundaries

 What it means: Reasserting clear personal limits so others cannot define or erase your identity.



 Boundaries protect your intrinsic worth and prevent future appropriation of your selfhood. Remember, someone's opinion about you is just an opinion. That's all it means. Don't let others change the course of your life with their negative views of you.



# 2. Grounding and embodiment practices

 What it means: Reconnect with your body and presentmoment awareness to feel whole again, in your spiritual life, physical life, mental life, business, life, and relationship life.



 The body often carries the imprint of trauma or rejection; embodiment restores felt sense of self.



# 3. Revisit your core values and beliefs

- Re-align with what you truly stand for, independent of others' opinions.
- A strong value compass anchors your identity beyond external validation.



# 4. Spiritual reconnection or reframe your identity

- Of us that they have never had reconnect yourself to the God image. Act like God.
- Many people find healing and reclaim their true self in their reconnection to the divine.



- 5. Healing through confession, forgiveness, and release
  - Process grievances to free yourself from ongoing self-doubt, resentment and bitterness.



- 6. Reclaim your narrative
  - Own your story instead of letting others define it.



### 7. Seek supportive communities

 Surround yourself with people who honor your humanity and dignity and those who are your divinity and humanity.



- 8. Develop self-care as a sacred practice
  - Prioritize activities that replenish energy, joy, and self-respect.



- 9. Restore "you" through practical autonomy
  - Rebuild the experience of control in daily life.
  - Demonstrated competence reinforces your God-given or intrinsic worth.



# 10. Seek professional guidance when needed

- Get expert support to process harm, trauma, or deep identity issues.
- Find a therapist or counselor who aligns with your spiritual or cultural perspective.
